7. Bobby had two mittens and Mary had four mittens. How many mittens were there all together?

8. The farmer had 10 cows and one bull. Each cow had a baby calf, what was the total number of cattle in the barn?

9. The farmer and his wife had a lot of mouths to feed during the winter. Count the number of mouths he fed.

10. The winter was long and cold it lasted from December 1 to April 10th. How many days of winter did the farm have? (It was not a leap year.)
